IRISH WHISKEY STYLES

Irish Whiskey has an incredible history and can lay claim to having the first written reference for any whiskey in the world. This stretches over the last nine centuries, overcoming famines, wars, political changes and its near disappearance in the early 20th century.

We hope to show you some of the past, present and future of the world of Irish Whiskey.

There are four distinct styles of Irish Whiskey.

Pot Still Whiskey

A uniquely Irish style of whiskey, generally produced using a mash of at least 30% malted and 30% un-malted barley, occasionally using up to 5% other grains such as oats, rye or wheat.

'Pot Still' actually refers to the inclusion of the raw grain, rather than the vessel used in distillation. The inclusion of unmalted barley gives Irish Whiskey a distinct flavour and mouthfeel that sets it apart from Scotch or bourbon.

Malt Whiskey

This style of whiskey is defined by the use of a mash of 100% malted barley. Malting as a process dates back over 6000 years. The process involves steeping the raw grain in water to cause it to sprout. This artificial germination generates the enzymes needed to better convert starches into sugar and alcohol during fermentation, before distillation.

Grain Whiskey

This style of whiskey is set apart by a mash containing up to 95% maize, wheat or rye rather than the traditional barley. It is typically distilled in column stills and matured for at least three years in wooden casks before being bottled at no less than 40% abv.

Blended Whiskey

This is the largest category of whiskey, making up over 90% of all sales in Ireland. A blended Irish Whiskey can use varying combinations of grain, pot still and malt whiskeys, each of different ages from different casks to achieve.



MIDLETON 'CHARLIE CHAWKE' 28 YEAR OLD SINGLE POT STILL SINGLE CASK EDITION

2019 marked the release of our first Single Cask bottling in collaboration with the Midleton Distillery, the Pinnacle of Irish Whiskey.

Carefully selected by father and son, Charlie and Bill Chawke, alongside former Midleton Master Distiller Brian Nation, this is truly one of the rarest Single Cask Irish whiskeys ever released.

Bonded on the 4th of July 1990, this single pot still distillate was matured for 28 years in a first-fill bourbon cask before being bottled at natural cask strength.

The cask yielded just 168 bottles, making it the oldest and rarest Single Cask expression for the Midleton Distillery.

Tasting notes:

Nose:

Rich toasted wood with a bold nutty character at the forefront, while delicate hints of citrus zest develop over time, giving balance to the mild pot still spices that remain constant in the background.

Palate:

Rich in fruit notes with sweet pears developing into more exotic fruits of peach, apricot and mango. Delicate sweet vanilla works in tandem with the pot still spices and subtle tannins adding a sense of balance and structure.

Finish:

Rich and lingering with the fruit constantly building over time while pot still spices fade, letting toasted oak linger until the very end.

Midleton Distillery

Dating back to 1825, Midleton is now Ireland's largest and most prolific distillery. Nestled in Co. Cork, the new Midleton distillery opened in 1975 which secured the future of many of Ireland's most beloved brands such as Jameson, Powers, Redbreast, the Spots and more.

Home to Irish whiskey icons, they've also developed an experimental range; Method and Madness.

Searsons of Baggot Street is the only bar in the world to house two full Midleton Very Rare collections, with two bottles on display from every year, 1984 - present year.

Midleton

The Pinnacle of Irish Whiskey, this brand laid the foundation for premium whiskey in Ireland and continues to excel. The Very Rare blended whiskey is an icon and it's been joined by several single pot still releases in recent years, experimenting with Irish oak and other single cask variations.

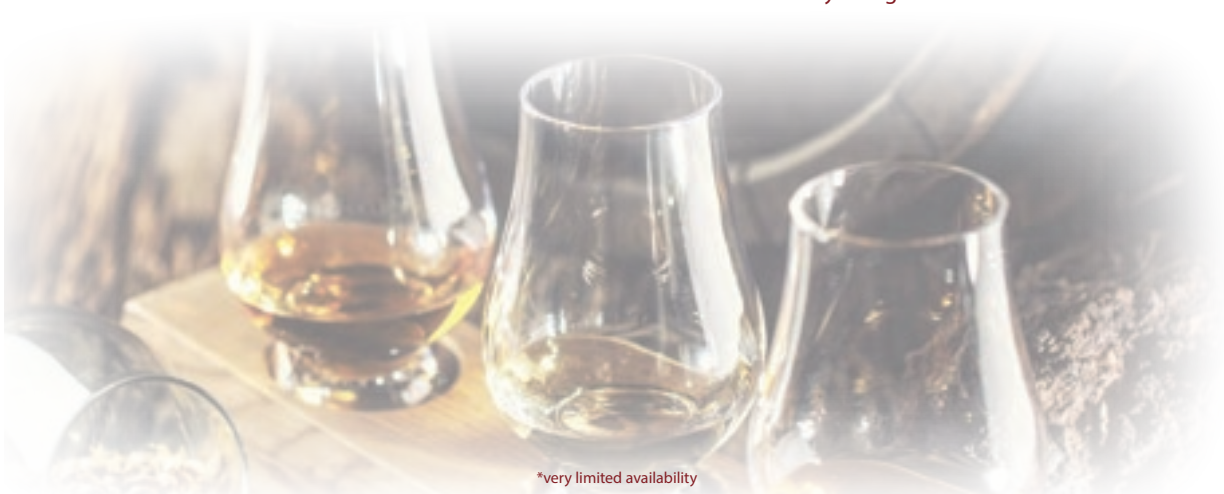

Walsh Whiskey

The brainchild of Bernard Walsh, what started out as an Irish coffee liqueur brand soon became one of the first independant bottlers to gain traction in the Irish market.

Their brands The Irishman and Writer's Tears have a great following in Ireland and they have some of the country's most unique blends. Their whiskeys are currently distilled under contract by Midleton as they no longer have their own distillery, though they are working towards building a new one in their home of Co. Carlow.



Teelings

The Teelings Distillery opened its doors in 2015 as the first new distillery in Dublin in over 125 years. Owned by brothers Jack and Stephen Teeling, they've gained global acclaim through their independantly bottled releases and have now begun to release their own whiskey into the Irish market. Walter Teeling established the first Teeling Distillery in 1782, and the brother's choice of a phoenix rising from a pot still in their logo symbolises the rebirth of the brand in 2015.

Dunville's

Dunville's is a famous old Irish whiskey brand that started in 1808 in their own Royal Irish Distillery in Belfast. After the death of Robert Dunville (5th generation family owner) in 1931, no-one was able to take over the company and in 1935, distillation stopped. The distillery was liquidated and demolished in the years after and it was thought the brand was lost forever, until its resurrection nearly 80 years later in 2012 by the new Echlinville Distillery.

Japanese Whisky gained global acclaim in recent years through its incredible value in the collector's market. The majority of their distilleries are located in regions with a similar climate to Scotland, and as such is a style of whiskey closer to Scotch than Irish or American. Like all other whiskies however, for any whisky to be called 'Japanese Whisky', it must be fermented, distilled, aged and bottled in Japan and also use water sourced from Japan.

Scotch Whiskies

This selection of Scotch Single Malt whiskies has been curated to showcase the vast array of flavour profiles available in Scotch whisky. It's a mixture of some of the most iconic Scotch whisky brands known worldwide, categorised by their regions.

Blended

Like Irish Whiskey, blended Scotch makes up 90% of all Scotch made and sold worldwide. A mix of 15%-40% single malt and 60%-85% single grain, sometimes featuring up to 30 different whiskies in the blend.

Speyside

These single malts are distilled in regions around the lush and fertile valley of the River Spey in northeastern Scotland, where over half of the country's distilleries can be found.

Lowland

A style of Scotch known for its lighter, sweet and more floral character.

Highland

From the largest whisky region in the north of Scotland comes an array of different styles and flavour profiles.

Islay & Skye

Whiskies from the western Isles of Skye & Islay are famed for their peaty, smoky character.

Orkney

The northernmost of Scotland's whisky producing regions features only two distilleries. These whiskies are known for their full-bodied and balanced flavour with smoky, salty character.

One island, two distilleries. A style of island whisky distinctively 'non-smoky'.

The American wing of Japanese premium spirit company Suntory produces old and new bourbons Jim Beam (1795) and Maker's Mark (1953) in bourbon's birthplace, Kentucky, as well as the Canadian giant Canadian Club in Ontario.
